filing a record 959 proposals for

<u>Grant Program</u>. The applicants
—which continue to represent a
wide variety of causes,

including education, food insecurity, elder care, and healthcare—submitted requests to be considered for 150 grants, totaling \$30 million, to be awarded next June. The Foundation's team of volunteer reviewers is now evaluating the proposals to determine which will be invited to submit full applications.
