New Safety Legislation: Effective **February 25**, *An Act Requiring the Hands-Free Use of Mobile Telephones While Driving* will take effect in Massachusetts. The new legislation will prohibit individuals from engaging in the following activities while driving a motor vehicle: holding a mobile phone or other electronic device; viewing text, images, or video on said device; and operating the device in a non-hands-free mode. <u>Learn more</u> about the specifics of the anti-distracted driving law and the penalties for breaking it.
