

Friendly Reminders

The Glass Men Cometh: Those who happen to look out their office windows and see someone looking back holding a squeegee should not be alarmed. We are scheduled to perform our standard seasonal exterior window cleaning starting June 28 and continuing throughout the month of July (weather permitting). During the next few weeks, more than 2,500 windows will be cleaned and left shining like new! Building entrances will remain accessible; however, certain sidewalks and parking areas may be periodically blocked off to accommodate our work.

In accordance with [Massachusetts Smoke-Free Workplace Law](#), smoking is prohibited at all times *anywhere* inside Cummings Properties' garages or buildings or in an outside area where smoke may migrate into the building. This law also applies to the use of e-cigarettes, which are considered "nicotine delivery products" and are comparable to tobacco cigarettes. Those who wish to smoke must do so **at least 30 feet away from any entrance, window, walkway, stairwell, or loading dock**. In addition, client firms with after-hours staff should remind employees that building entrance doors should *not* be propped open at any time, including when employees leave the building briefly to smoke.
