Recommended Video: Cummings Center's existence can be attributed to many people, but foremost among them is **Jamie McKeown**. The late president of Cummings Properties, Jamie advocated for and then led our firm's purchase of the then-derelict United Shoe Machinery Corporation's former world headquarters in Beverly in 1996.
