





2026 Grant Cycle Underway:
Local nonprofits turned their
fundraising efforts to the web,
filing a record 959 proposals
for the <u>Cummings \$30 Million</u>
<u>Grant Program</u>. The applicants
—which continue to represent
a wide variety of causes,

including education, food insecurity, elder care, and healthcare—submitted requests to be considered for 150 grants, totaling \$30 million, to be awarded next June. The Foundation's team of volunteer reviewers is now evaluating the proposals to determine which will be invited to submit full applications. 

# **Friendly Reminders**

**Fall Back:** Daylight Saving Time ends **Sunday, November 2**. Remember to set the clocks *back* one hour before going to bed on **Saturday, November 1**.

**Holiday Note:** Cummings' offices and maintenance departments will have limited staff on site on **Monday, October 13** in honor of Columbus/Indigenous Peoples' Day.

Avoid Property Damage from Frozen Pipes: As winter sets in, we remind all resident firms to help protect the premises and its plumbing by keeping their suites set to at least 60° Fahrenheit at all times. Prolonged exposure to the cold can cause pipes to freeze and rupture, yielding substantial



water damage. Please keep the heat running, especially during nights and weekends when the space is unoccupied, and take care that all windows and doors are completely closed and latched shut at the end of each day.
