Shoe Snippets

Fun facts about the historic Cummings Center site, formerly known as "The Shoe"

United Shoe recognized the importance of providing small luxuries for its employees. Among the amenities available to them were a clubhouse, athletic fields, shooting ranges, and gardening plots. Although non-employees were allowed to join the clubhouse, 75 percent of the membership was reserved for factory workers. As for the gardening plots, 300 acres was

more land than The Shoe needed for its business operations, so it allowed employees to utilize the surrounding farmland free of charge. Workers were permitted to seek assistance from agriculturists in this endeavor, but were responsible for the cost of these services to ensure they felt they were paying their own way.
